This deadlines calendar is intended to be a practical summary guide to the end-of-session deadlines. It is not intended as an interpretation of the rules of the House or Senate.

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Note 2: The House rules do not have an express deadline for distributing calendars on the 120th, 121st, 128th, 132nd, and 133rd days. This calendar presumes that the House will convene at 9 a.m. for a local and consent calendar and at 10 a.m. for a daily or supplemental calendar.

Note 3: The Senate deadline for passing all bills and joint resolutions **does not** take into consideration the House deadline for passing Senate bills and joint resolutions. **Realistically**, to eligible for consideration by the House under its end-of-session, Senate bills and joint resolutions must be passed by the Senate and received by the House **before** the 130th day.

Note 4: Both Senate and House rules require a 48-hour layout for a resolution, suspending limitations on a conference committee considering the general appropriations bill, if such a resolution is necessary. Neither rule has an express deadline for considering that resolutions, which should occur before consideration of the general appropriation bill.
